Scholarship Program Overview

HAVE-STR is proud to support the educational aspirations of students whose families are Public Housing or Housing Choice Voucher (HCV) Section 8 Program residents through our annual scholarship program. This opportunity is open to students of 2025 HAVE-STR member agencies in good standing.

Scholarship Awards

This year, HAVE-STR will award a total of **15 scholarships**:

- Three (3) scholarships of \$1,000 each
- Twelve (12) scholarships of \$600 each

Eligibility Criteria

- Applicants must be high school seniors graduating this academic year.
- Applicants must be a Public Housing or HCV Section 8 program resident of a HAVE-STR member agency in good standing.
- Demonstrate exceptional school attendance.
- Demonstrate high academic and leadership achievement.

Application Checklist

- 1. Completed Scholarship Application
- 2. HAVE-STR Scholarship Local Housing Agency's Certification signed by the Executive Director
- 3. High School Transcript or Certified Copy of Grades
- 4. Two (2) Letters of Recommendation
 - One Letter from a Community Leader: *This could be a coach, religious leader, employer, or other individuals active in the community.*
 - One Letter from a High School Teacher or Counselor
- 5. Wallet-Sized Senior Photo (Optional)

- The complete application packet must contain one (1) original and six (6) copies of all the above documents and must be sealed.
